

**National Workshop on
Faculty Development Program
March 29-31, 2015**

A national workshop on the Faculty Development Program (FDP) is to be organized by the Teaching-Learning Cell of Indian Institute of Technology (Banaras Hindu University) during March 29-31, 2015. The focus of the workshop is on three main aspects; (i) Assist faculty to write learning outcomes of a course that they teach, (ii) Enable the faculty to conduct Active and Cooperative Learning Sessions and (iii) develop Assessment techniques to measure the intended learning occurred or not (apart from the exams). Last but not the least it will address questions about motivation and reflective teaching.
