SECTION1:INSTRUCTIONFORONLINEBIDSUBMISSION

The bidders are required tosubmitsoftcopiesoftheirbidselectronicallyontheCPPPortal, usingvalidDigitalSignatureCertificates. The instructions given below are meant to assist the bidders in registering on the CPPPortal, prepare their bids in accordance with the requirements and submitting their bids online on theCPPPortal.

1. Registration

- 1. Bidders are required to enroll on the e-Procurement module of the Central Public ProcurementPortal (URL:<u>http://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app)</u>by clicking on the link "Click here to Enroll".Enrolmenton theCPP Portal is free of charge.
- 2. As part of the enrolment process, the bidders will be required to choose a unique username and assignapassword for their accounts.
- 3. Bidders are advised to register their valid email address and mobile numbers as part of theregistrationprocess. ThesewouldbeusedforanycommunicationfromtheCPPPortal.
- 4. Upon enrolment, the bidders will be required to register their valid Digital Signature Certificate(Class II or Class III Certificates with signing key usage) issued by any Certifying AuthorityrecognizedbyCCAIndia(e.g. Sify/TCS /nCode/ eMudhraetc.), with their profile.
- 5. Only one valid DSC should be registered by a bidder. Please note that the bidders are responsible to ensure that they do not lend their DSCs to others which may lead to misuse.

The Bidder shall bear all costs associated with the preparation and submission of its bid, and "thePurchaser", will in no case be responsible or liable for these costs, regardless of the conduct oroutcomeofthebiddingprocess.

B. The Bidding Documents

3. TenderProcessingFees

The Tender Processing fees (ForIndian Bidders:Rs. 5,900.00/-) should be submitted ONLINEasper the details mentioned above. Further, the proof of payment must be uploaded with Technical Bid.Theexemption will be applicable as per Govt. ofIndianorms.

4. ContentofBiddingDocuments

Thegoodsrequired, biddingprocedures and contract terms are prescribed in the bidding documents.

18. EvaluationofTechnocommercialun-pricedBid

Priortothedetailedtechnicalevaluation,thepurchaserwilldeterminethesubstantialresponsivenessofeachbi d.Asubstantiallyresponsivebidisone,whichconformstoallthetermsandconditionsofthe Bidding Documents without material deviations and meets all the essential pre-bid criteria. 2. Application

These General Conditions shall apply to the extent that they are not superseded by provisions in otherpartsofthe Contract.

3. Standards

The Goods supplied under this Contract shall conform to the standards mentioned in the TechnicalSpecifications, and, when no applicable standard is mentioned, to the authoritative standard appropriate to the Goods' country of origin and such standards shall be the latest issued by the concerned Institution.

4. UseofContractDocumentsandInformation

The Supplier shall not, without the Purchaser's prior written consent, disclose the Contract, or any provision thereof, or any specification, plan, drawing, pattern, sample or information furnished by oron behalf of the Purchaser in connection therewith, to any person other than a person employed by theSupplier in performance of the Contract. Disclosure to any such employed person shall be made inconfidenceand shall extend onlyso far as maybenecessaryforpurposes of such performance.

The Supplier shall not, without the Purchaser's prior written consent, make use of any document orinformationexcept forpurposes of performing the Contract.

Any document, other than the Contract itself, shall remain the property of the Purchaser and shall bereturned (in all copies) to the Purchaser on completion of the Supplier's performance under theContractif so required by the Purchaser.

5. PatentRights

The Supplier shall indemnify the Purchaser against all third-party claims of infringement of patent,trademarkor industrial designrights arisingfromuseof theGoods oranypart thereof in India.

6. Submissionofthebids.

7. InspectionsandTests

The Purchaser or its representative shall have the right to inspect and/or to test the Goods to confirm their conformity to the Contract specifications at no extracost to the Purchaser.

The inspections and tests may be conducted on the premises of the Supplier or its subcontractor(s), atpoint of delivery and/or at the Goods final destination. If conducted on the premises of the Supplier oritssubcontractor(s), allreasonable facilities and assistance, including access to drawings and production dat a shall be furnished to the inspectors at no charge to the Purchaser.

Should any inspected or tested Goods fail to conform to the specifications, the Purchaser may reject goods and the Supplier shall either replace the rejected Goods or make alterations necessary tomeetspecification requirements free f costto the Purchaser.

The Purchaser's right to inspect, test and, where necessary, reject the Goods after the Goods' arrival atProject Site shall in no way be limited or waived by reason of the Goods having previously beeninspected, tested and passed by the Purchaser or its representative prior to the Goods shipment.

Nothing in GCC Clause 7 shall in any way release the Supplier from any warranty or other obligations under this Contract.

8. Consequencesofrejection

If in the event the stores are rejected by the purchase ratthe destination and the supplier fails to make the store st

satisfactory supplies within the stipulated period of delivery, the purchaser will be at liberty to:

- (a) Allow the supplier to esubmit the stores in replacement of those rejected, within a specified time without any extra cost to the purchaser or
- (b) Reject the material, which shall be final and binding on the contractor.
- (c) Procure the rejected materials of comparable quality from the open market/Govt. stores and the supplier shall be liable to pay the difference in price over the RC prices or get the amountadjusted from the outstanding bills of the supplier rEMD, if any.

9. Packing

The Supplier shall provide such packing of the Goods as is required to prevent their damage ordeterioration during transit to their final destination as indicated in the Contract. The packingshall besufficient to withstand, without limitation, rough handling during transit and exposure to extremetemperatures, saltand precipitation during transit and openstorage. Packing case size andweightsshall take into consideration, where appropriate, the remoteness of the Goods' final destination and theabsence of heavyhandlingfacilities at all points in transit.

11. Insurance

12. Transportation

Where the Supplier is required under the Contract to transport the Goods within India defined asProjectsite,transporttosuchplaceofdestinationinIndiaincludinginsurance,asshallbespecified in the Contract, shall be arranged by the Supplier, and the related cost shall be included in the contractPrice.

13. Warranty

The Supplier warrants that the Goods supplied under this Contract are new, unused, of the mostrecent or current models and that they incorporate all recent improvements in design and materialsunless provided otherwise in the Contract. The Supplier further warrants that all Goods supplied under this Contract shall have no defect arising from design, materials or workmanship or from anyact or omission of the Supplier that may develop under normal use of the supplied Goods in theconditionsprevailinginIndia.

This warranty shall remain valid for at least **12 months**after the Goods or anyportion thereof as the case may be. have been delivered to and accepted at the final destinationindicated in the Contract, unless specified otherwise. The Purchasershall promptly notifytheSupplier in writing of any claims arising under this warranty. Upon receipt of such notice, theSupplier shall with all reasonable speed, repair or replace the defective Goods or parts thereof, without any extra cost to the Purchaser. If the Supplier, having been notified, fails to remedy thedefect(s) within a reasonable period, the Purchaser may proceed to take such remedial action as maybe necessary, at the Supplier's risk and expense and without prejudice to any other rights which thePurchasermayhaveagainst theSupplier under theContract.

14. Payment

Forimports:

100% payment shall be made through Letter of Credit. Out of this, 70% payment will be released against the invoice, inspection certificate, shipping documents & other required documents as per LCandremaining30% payment will be released after receiving of material satIIT (BHU), the issuccessful installation, acceptance of machine & submission of PBG by bidder and its confirmation from the Bank.

15. Prices

- (c) Theplaceofdelivery;and/or
- (d) TheservicestobeprovidedbytheSupplier.

If any such change causes an increase or decrease in the cost of, or the time required for, theSupplier's performance of any provisions under the Contract, an equitable adjustment shall be madein the Contract Price or delivery schedule, or both, and the Contract shall accordingly be amended. Any claims by the Supplier for adjustment under this clause must be asserted within thirty (30) daysfromthedate of theSupplier's receipt of thePurchaser's changeorder.

17. ContractAmendments

Subject to GCC Clause 16, no variation in or modification of the terms of the Contract shall be madeexcept bywrittenamendment signed bythe parties.

18. Assignment

The Supplier shall not assign, in whole or in part, its obligations to perform under the Contract, except with the Purchaser's prior written consent.

19. Subcontracts

The Supplier shall notify the Purchaser in writing of all subcontracts awarded under this Contract ifnot already specified in the bid. Such notification, in his original bid or later, shall not relieve theSupplierfrom anyliability or obligation under the Contract.

20. DelaysintheSupplier'sPerformance

Delivery of the Goods and performance of the Services shall be made by the Supplier in accordancewiththetime schedule specified by the Purchaseras per GCC clause10.

If at any time during performance of the Contract, the Supplier or its sub-contractor(s) shouldencounterconditionsimpedingtimely

deliveryoftheGoodsandperformanceofServices,theSupplier shall promptly notify the Purchaser in writing of the fact of the delay, its likely duration andits cause(s). As soon as practicable after receipt of the Supplier's notice, the Purchaser shall evaluate the situation and may, at its discretion, extend the Supplier's time for performance with or withoutliquidated damages, in which case the extension shall be ratified by the parties by amendment of theContract.

Except as provided under GCC Clause 23, a delay by the Supplier in the performance of its deliveryobligations shall render the Supplier liable to the imposition of penalty pursuant toGCC Clause 21,unless an extension of time is agreed upon pursuant to GCC Clause 20.2 without the application ofliquidateddamages.

21. Penalty

Subject to GCC Clause 23, if the Supplier fails to deliver and install any or all of the Goods or toperform the Services within the period(s) specified in the Contract, the Purchaser shall, without prejudice to its other remedies under the Contract, deduct from the Contract Price, as penalty, a sumequivalent to1% per week and the maximum deduction is 10% of the contract price of the delivered goods or unperformed Services for each week or part thereof of delay untilactual delivery or performance. Once the maximum is reached, the Purchaser may consider termination of the Contract pursuant to GCC Clause 22.

22. TerminationforDefault

ThePurchasermay, without prejudice to any other remedy for breach of contract, by written notice of default sent to the Supplier, terminate the Contract in whole or part:

- (a) If the Supplier fails to deliver any or all of the Goods within the period(s) specified in the purchase order, or within any extension thereof granted by the Purchaser pursuant to GCCClause20; or
- (b) If the Supplier fails to perform any other obligation (s) under the Contract.
- (c) If the Supplier, in the judgment of the Purchaser has engaged in corrupt or fraudulentpractices incompeting for orin executing the Contract.

23. ForceMajeure

For purposes of this Clause, "Force Majeure" means an event beyond the control of the Supplier and not involving the Supplier's fault or negligence and not foreseeable. Such events may include, but arenotlimited to, acts of the Purchasereither inits sovereign or contractual capacity, wars or revolutions, fires, floods, epidemics, quarantine restrictions and freight embargoes.

Ifa Force Majeure situation arises, the Supplier shall promptly notify the Purchaser in writing ofsuch conditions and the cause thereof. Unless otherwise directed by the Purchaser in writing, theSupplier shall continue to perform its obligations under the Contract as far as is reasonably practical, and shall seek all reasonable alternative means for performance not prevented by the Force Majeureevent.

24. TerminationforInsolvency

The Purchaser may at any time terminate the Contract by giving written notice to the Supplier, if theSupplierbecomesbankruptorotherwiseinsolvent.Inthisevent,terminationwillbewithoutCompensation n to the Supplier provided that such termination will not prejudice or affect any right ofactionorremedy, whichhas accruedorwillaccruethereafter to thePurchaser.

25. TerminationforConvenience

The Purchaser, by written notice sent to the Supplier, may terminate theContract, in whole or inpart, atanytime for its convenience. The notice of termination shall specify that termination is for the Purchaser's convenience, the extent to which performance of the Supplier under the Contract is terminated, and the date upon which such termination becomes effective.

The Goods that are complete and ready for shipment within 30 days after the Supplier's receipt ofnoticeof termination shall beaccepted by the Purchaser at the Contract terms and prices.

26. ResolutionofDisputes

The Purchaser and the supplier shall make every effort to resolve amicably by direct informalnegotiation any disagreement or dispute arising between them under or in connection with theContract.

If, after thirty (30) daysfrom the commencement of such informal negotiations, the Purchaser and the Supplier have been unable to resolve amicably a Contract dispute, either party may require that the disputebere ferred for resolution to the formal mechanisms asspecified below. These mechanisms may include, but are not limited to, conciliation mediated by a third party, adjudication in agreed national or international forum, and national or international arbitration.

In case of Dispute or difference arising between the Purchaser and a supplier relating to any matterarising out of or connected with this agreement, such disputes or difference shall be settled inaccordance with the Arbitration Act, 1996 as amended from timetotime.

27. GoverningLanguage

The contract shall be written in English language. Subject to GCC Clause 28, English languageversion of the Contract shall govern its interpretation. All correspondence and other documentspertainingto theContract which are exchanged by the parties shall be written in the same language.

28. ApplicableLaw

The contract shall be governed by the Law of Contract for the time being inforce.

Irrespective of theplace of delivery, the place of performance or place of paymentunder the contract, the contract shall be deemed to have been made at the place from which the acceptance oftenderhas been issued.

Jurisdiction of Courts: The courts of the place from where the acceptance of tender has been issuedshallalone havejurisdiction decide any dispute arising out of or in respect of this contract.

One-month notice will be given by either party for termination of Contract during the tenure of Contractforbreachof Clauseor otherwise.

29. TaxesandDuties

Suppliers shall be entirely responsible for all taxes, duties, license fees, road permits, etc., incurreduntildeliveryof the contracted Goods to the Purchaser.

Further, if required the Institute will make direct payment to Custom Department against receipt of Challan from the supplier.
