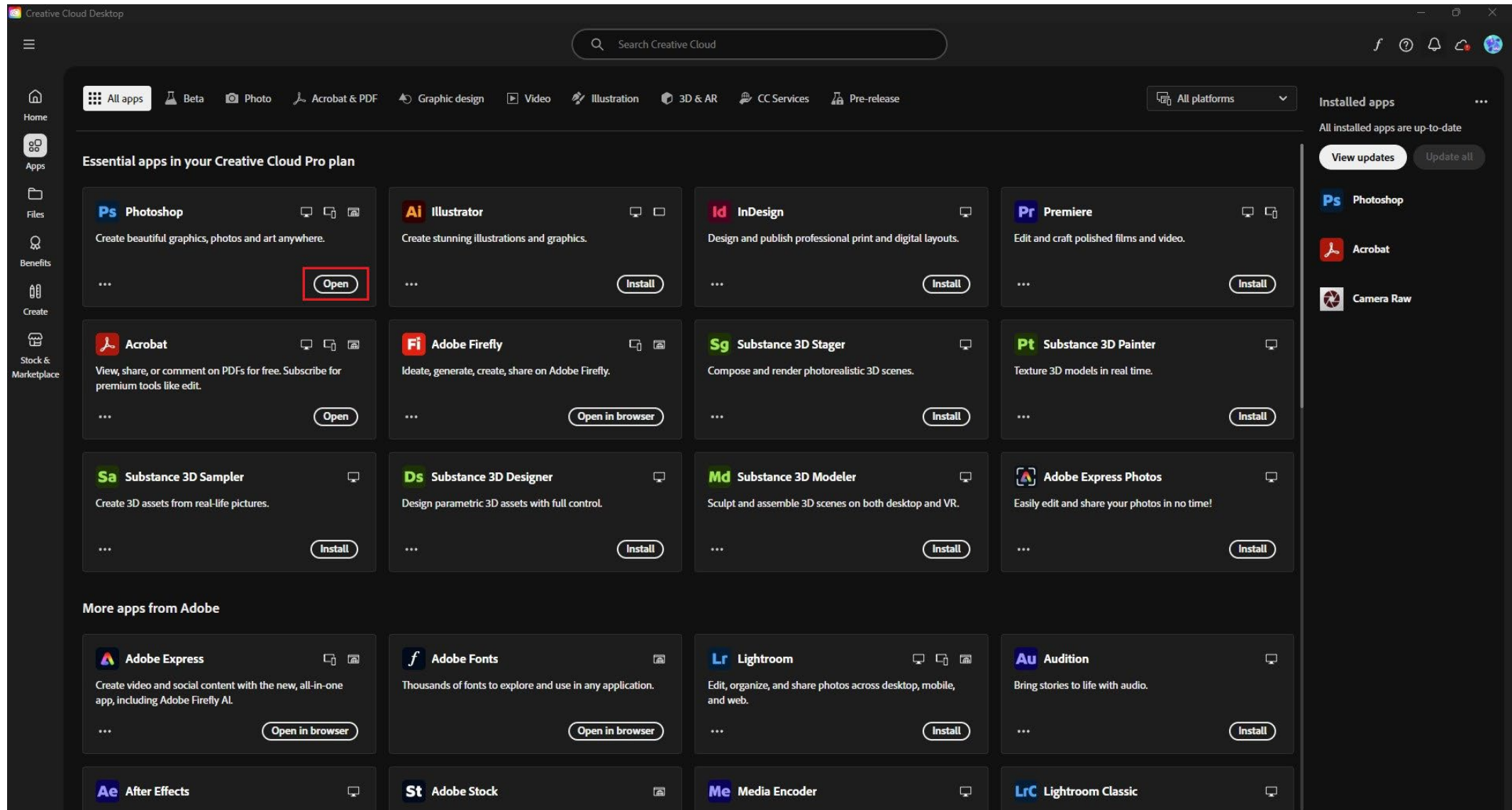
➤ Click on “Apps” this will take you to all the applications available in the Creative Cloud package
