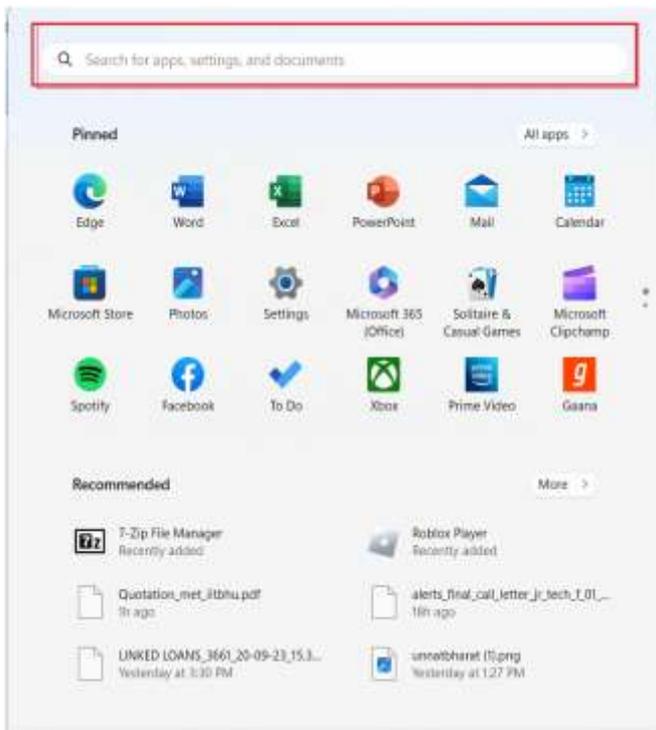
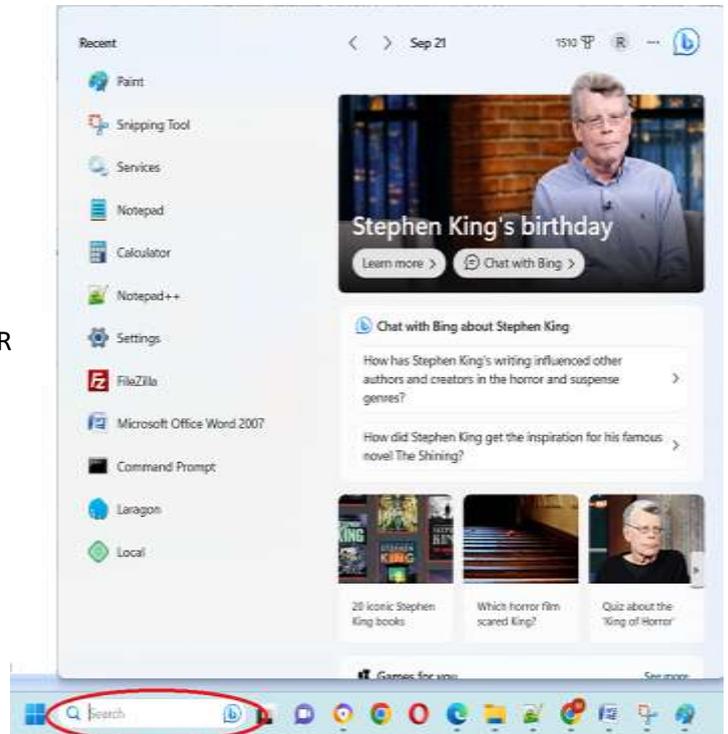


Procedure for Authenticating Wired Users

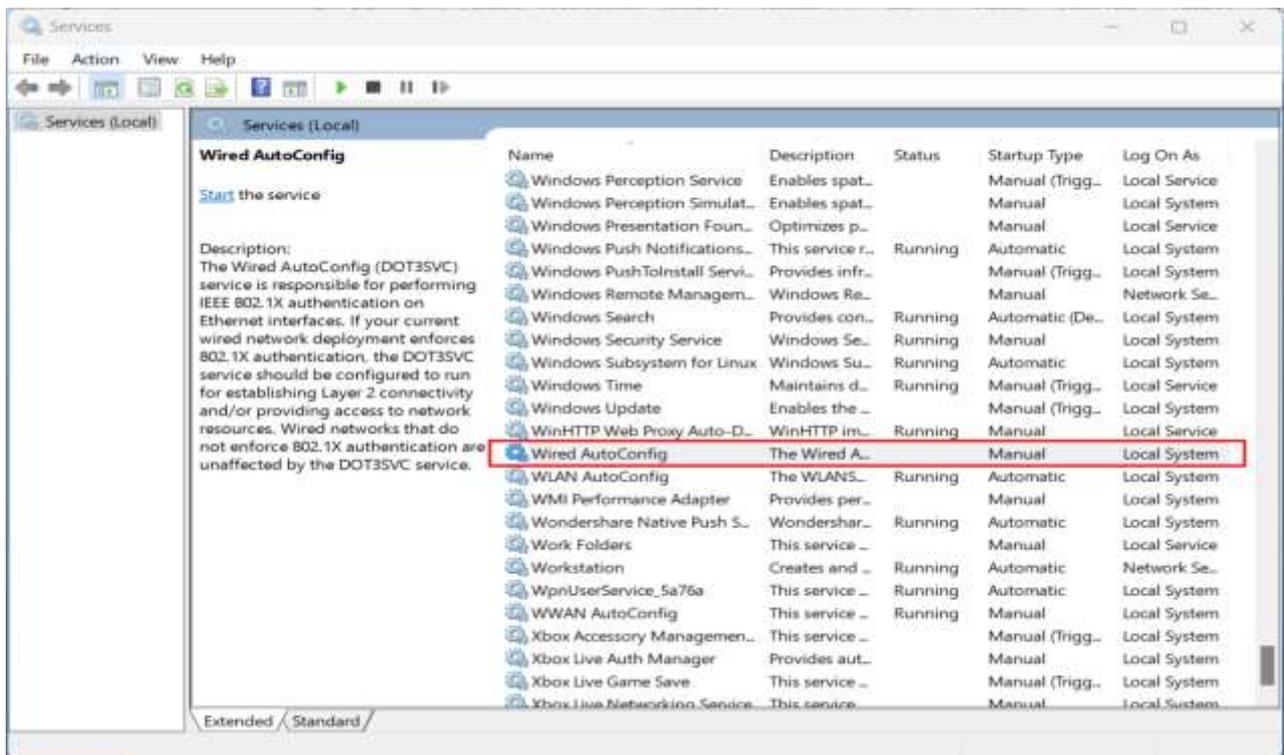
Step 1 : To access Services, simply click on the Windows button or search bar located on the taskbar, then input "Services" into the provided search box.



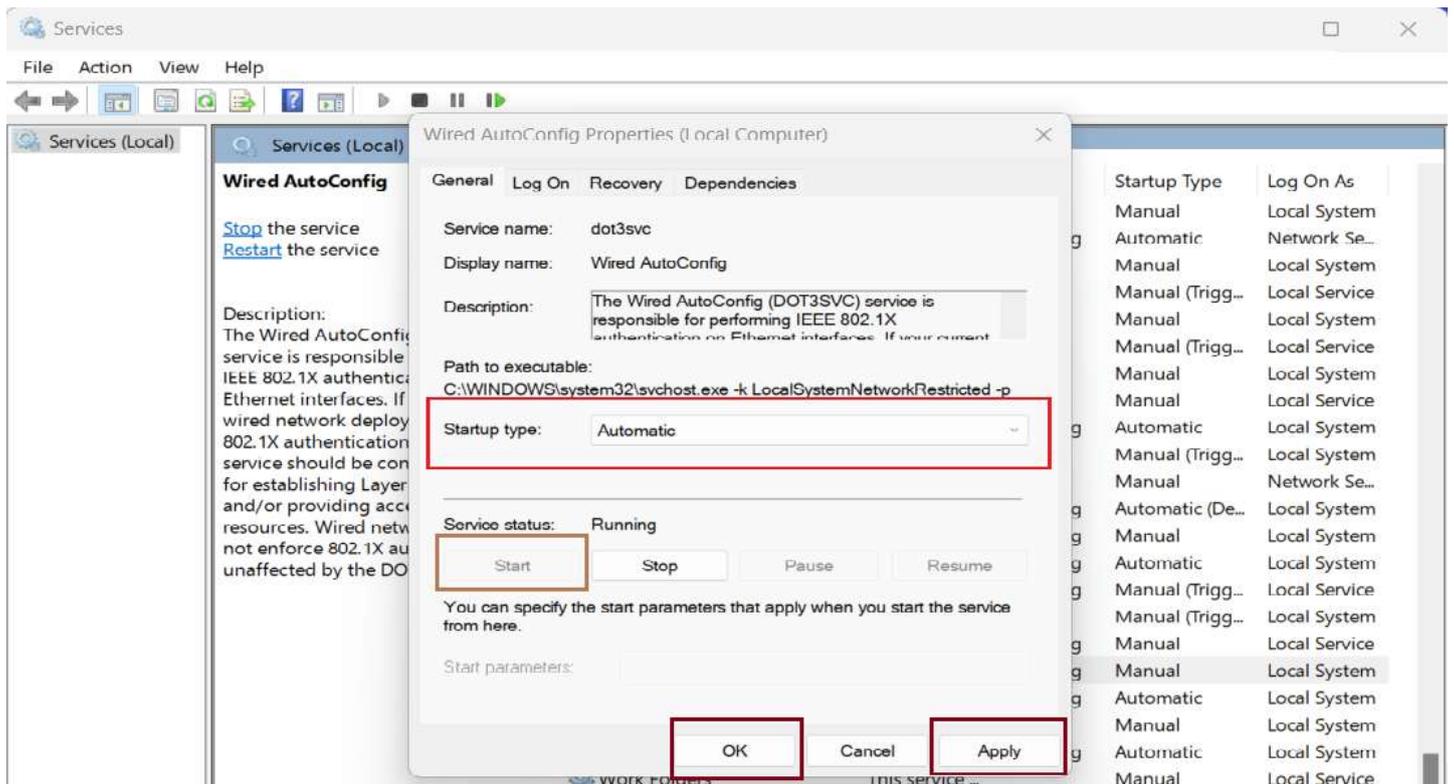

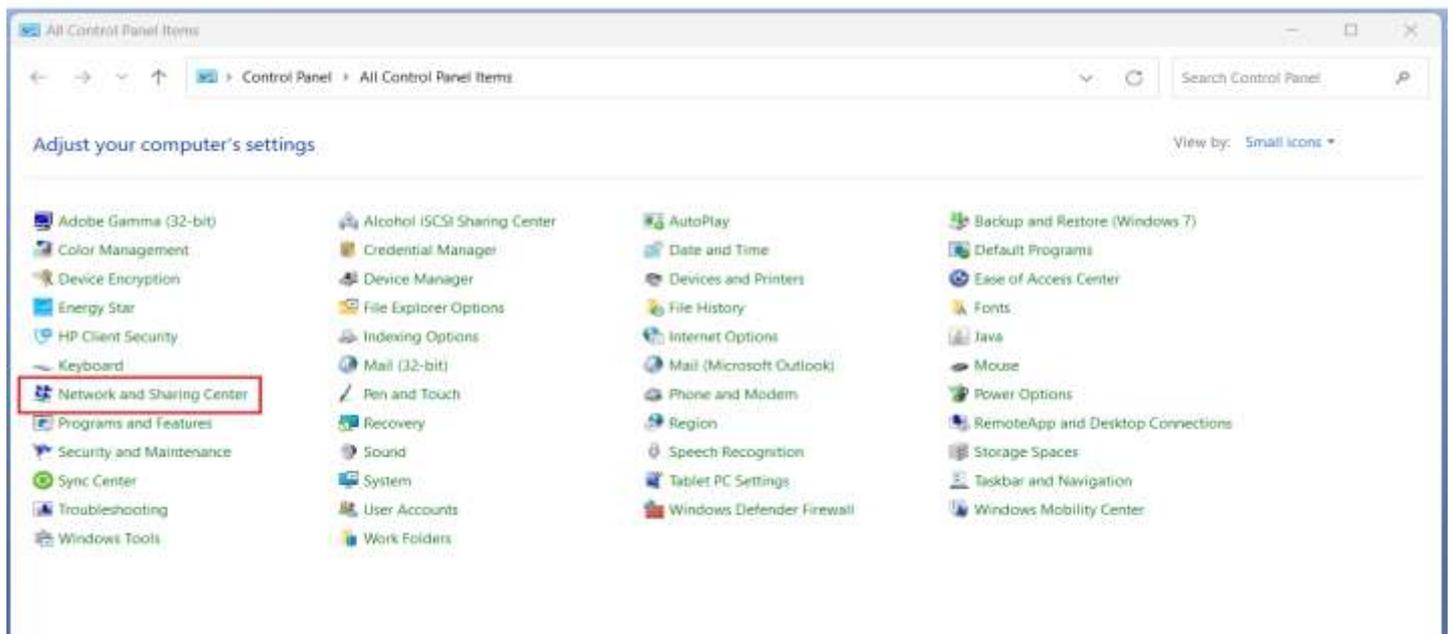
Step 2. Go to Wired Auto Config, as shown and open the "Wired AutoConfig properties" dialog box by double-clicking on it.

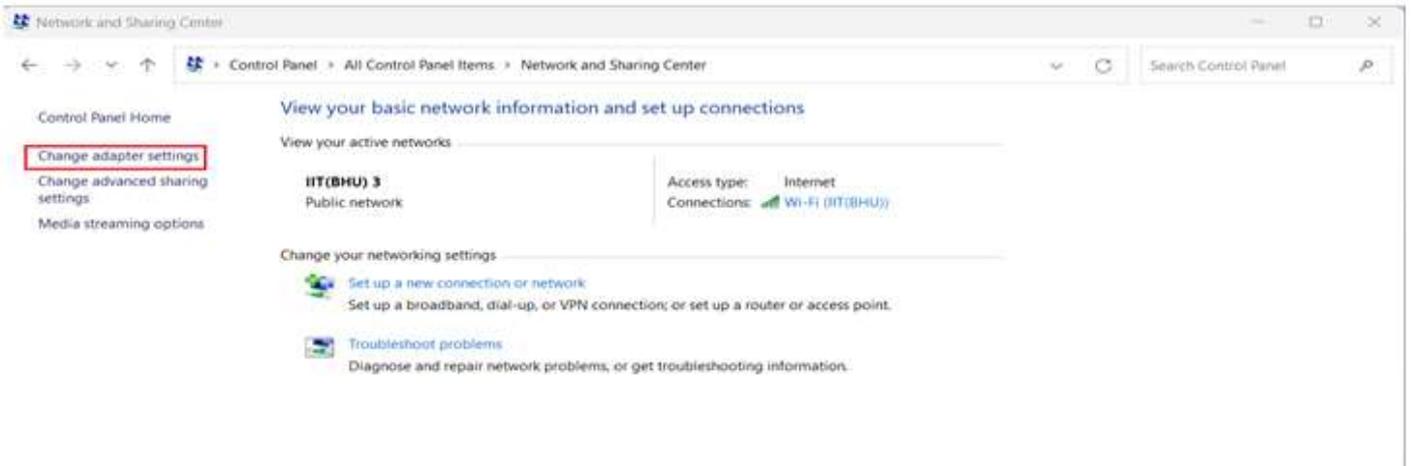

Step 4: Go to Control Panel > Network Sharing Center > Change Adapter Settings as shown

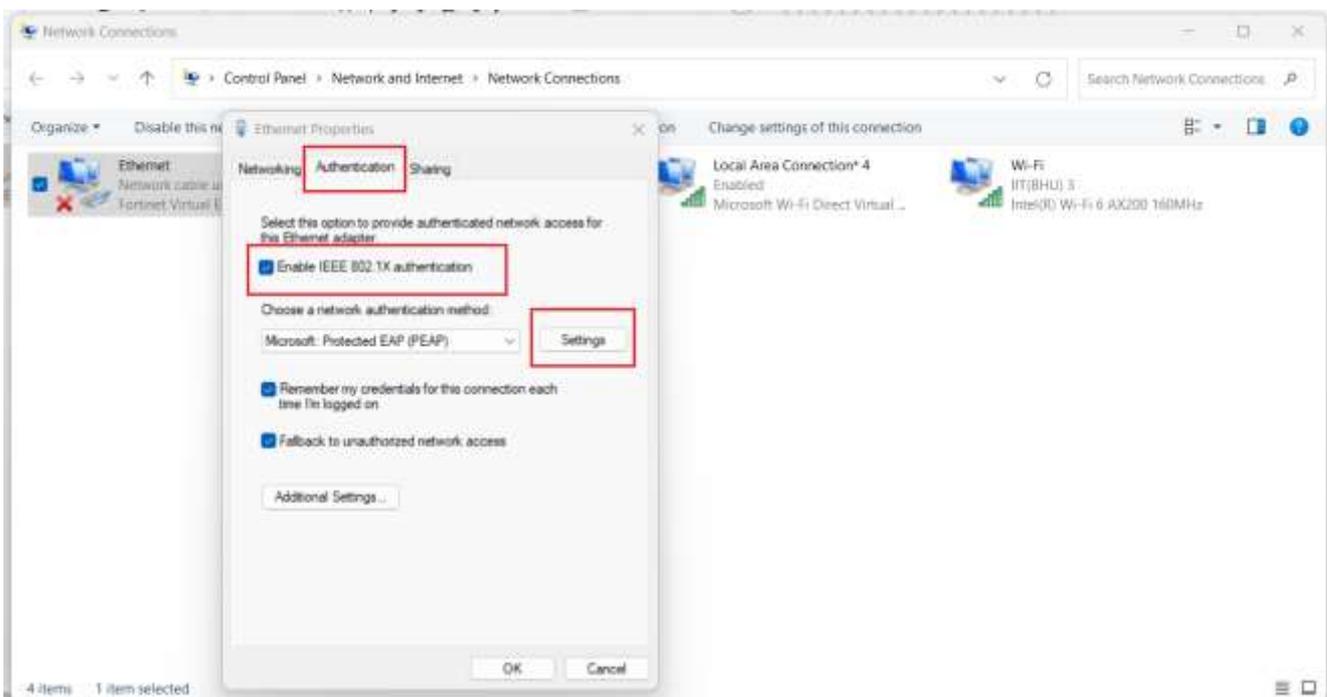




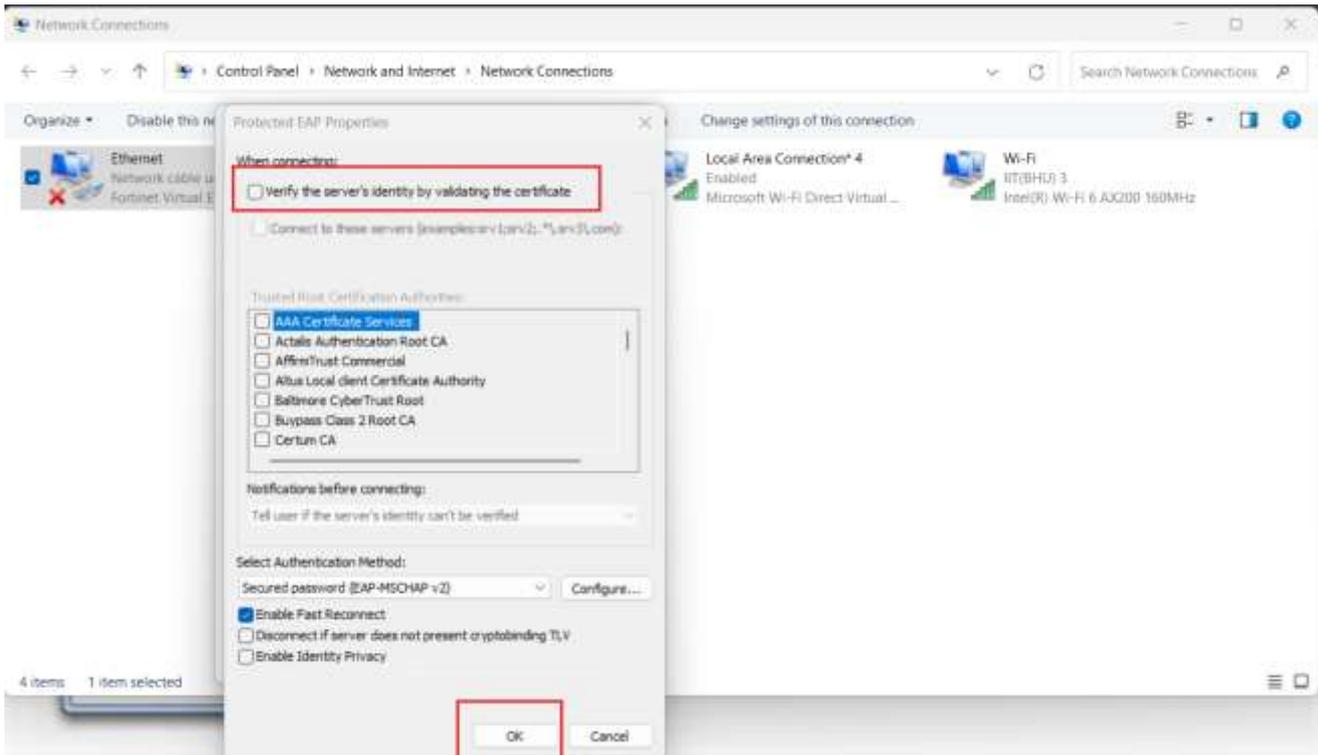
Step 5: Double click Ethernet icon



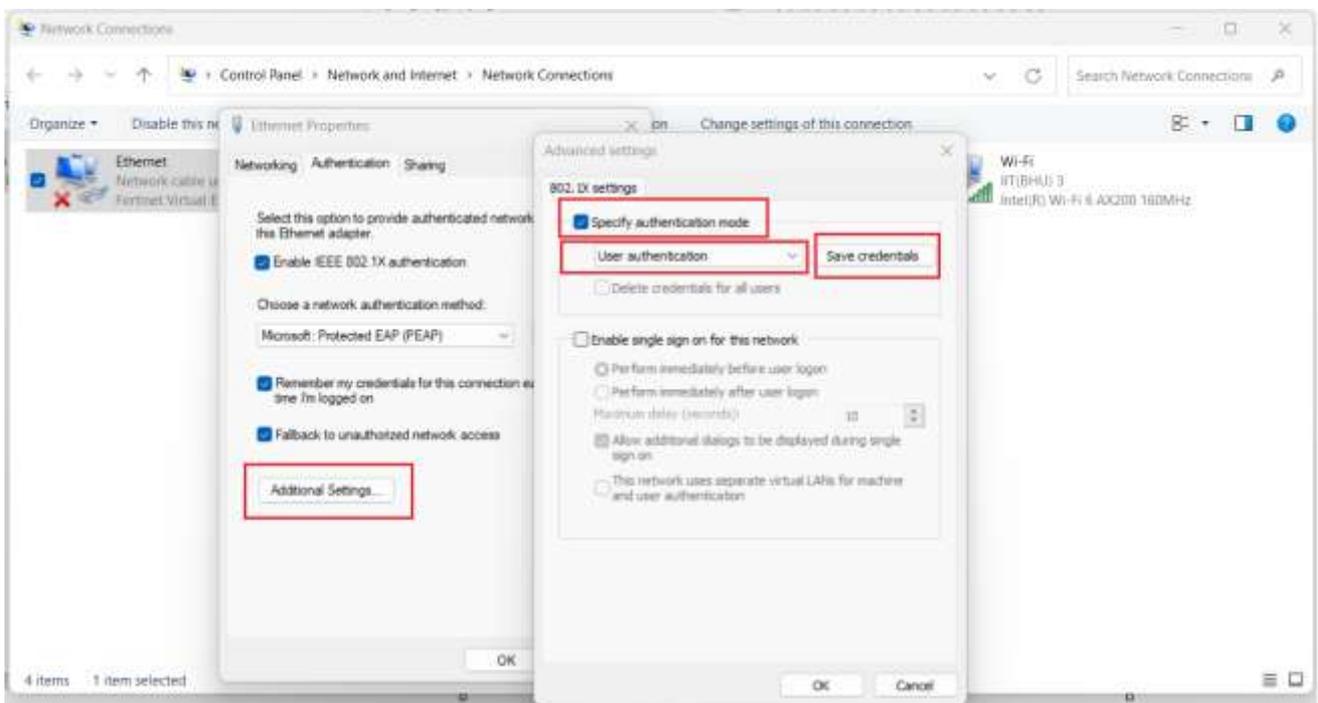

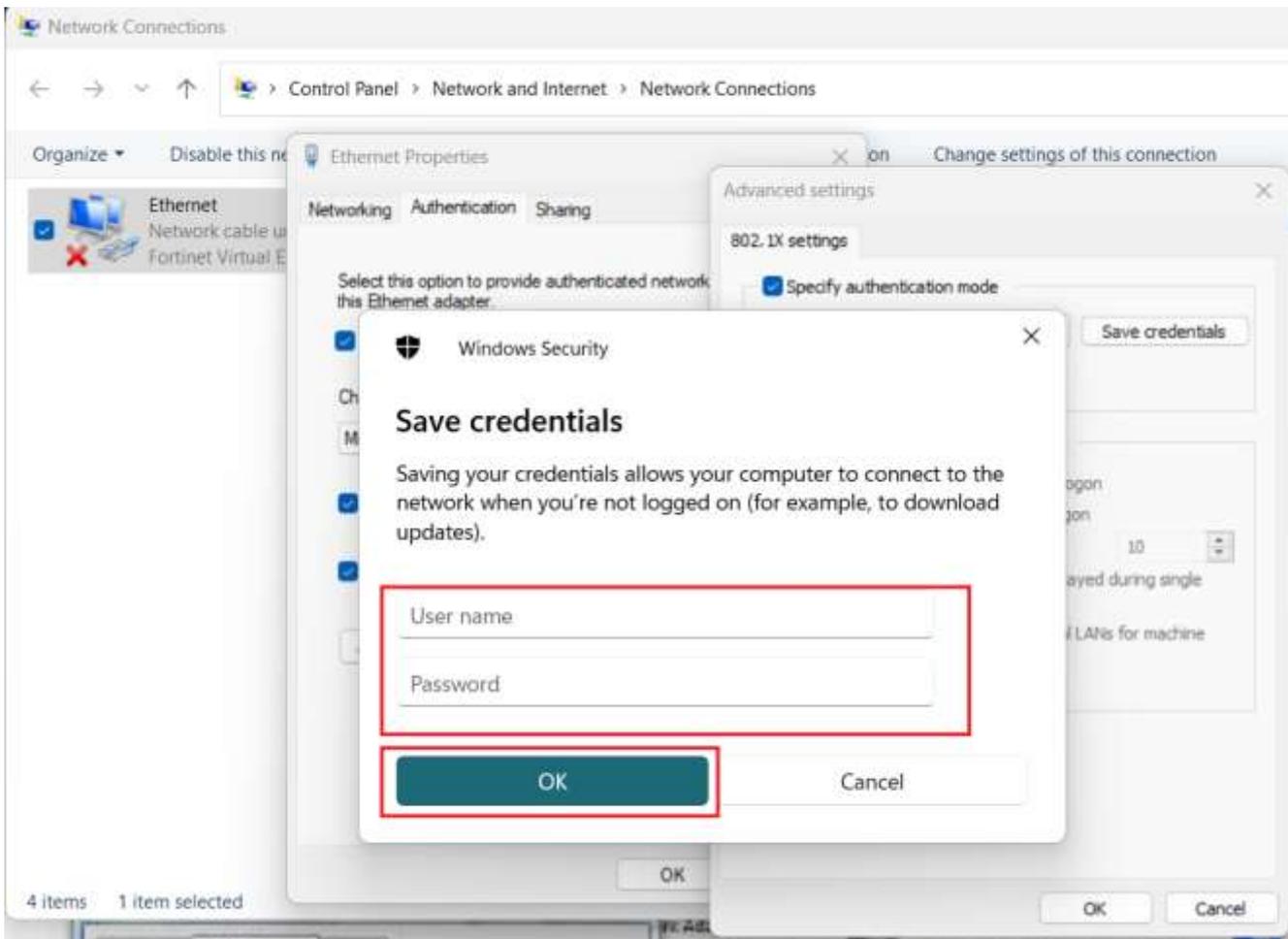
Step 6: Uncheck the Verify the server's identity by validating the certificate and click **OK** .



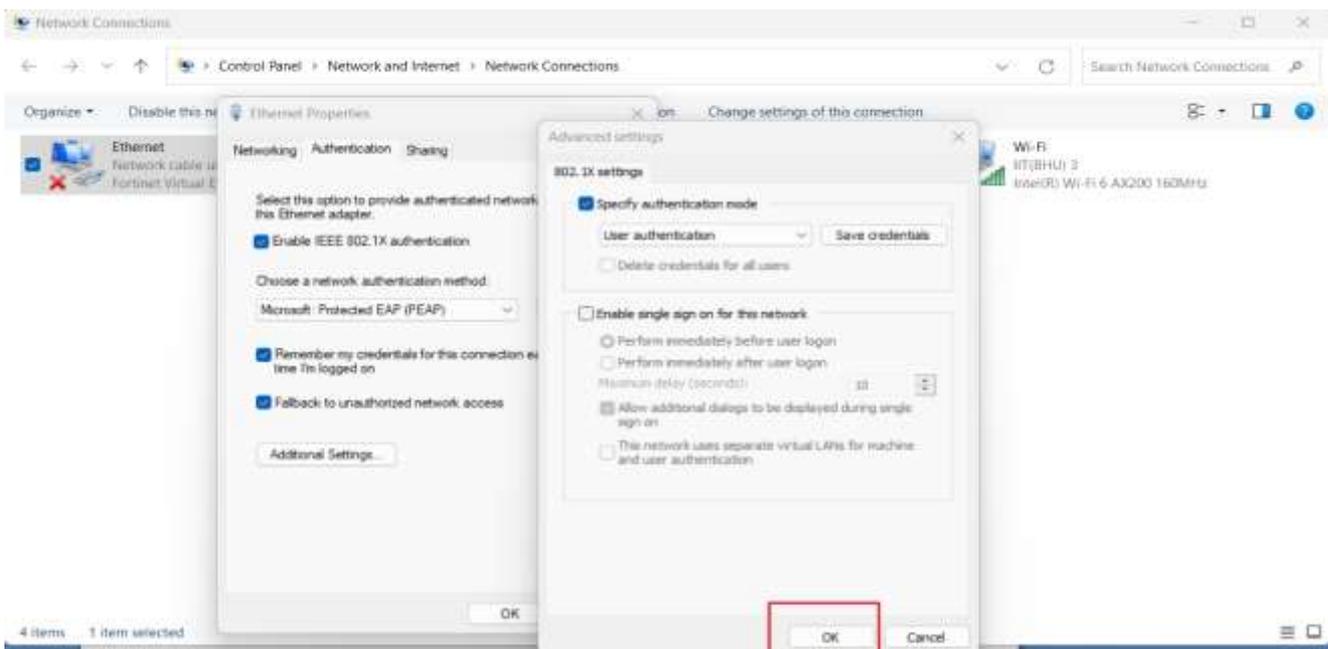

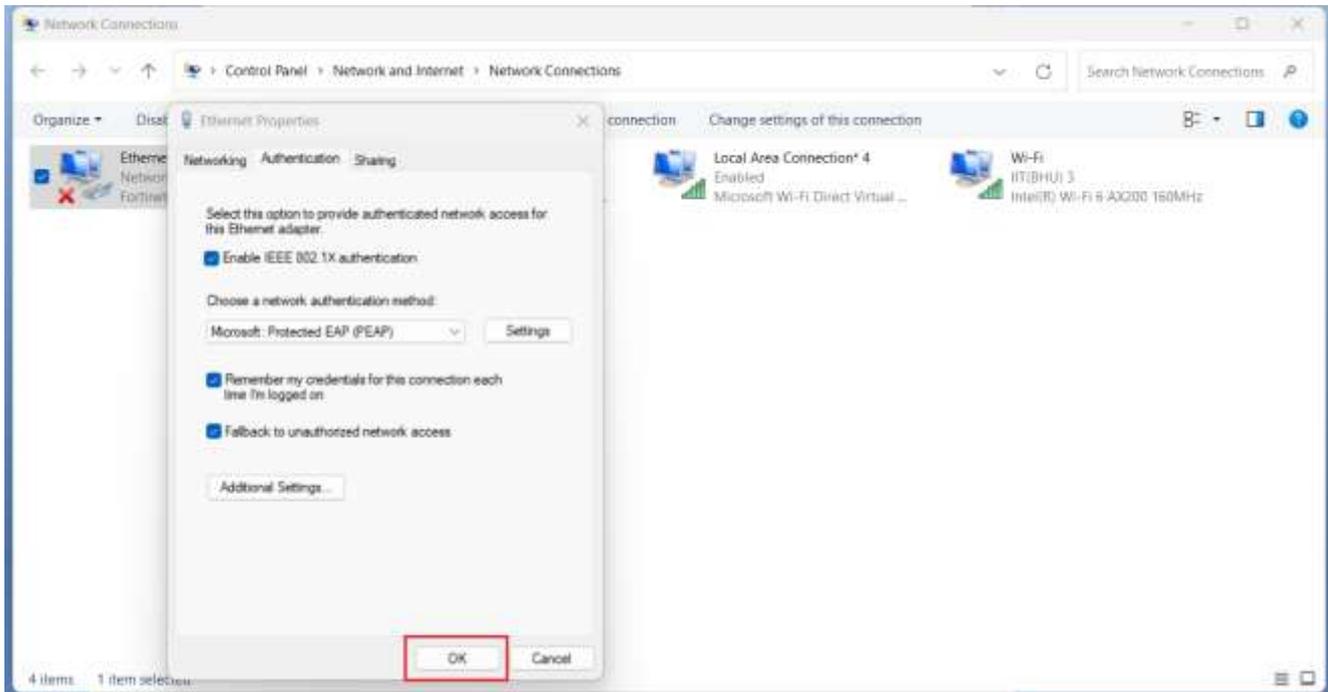
Step 8: Enter your internet credentials (username and password) in the dialog box provided and click ok.
