














Institute Updates

- 1. The Ministry of Heavy Industries has approved a Centre of Excellence (CoE) on Machine Tool Design at IIT (BHU). The CoE is being established with HMT Machine Tools Ltd. as an industry partner under the aegis of the Ministry of Heavy Industries, Govt. of India's Scheme on Enhancement of Competitiveness in the Indian Capital Goods Sector, Phase-II. The CoE aims to enhance the global competitiveness in the capital goods sector and expedition of R&D activities by utilizing academia of repute, IIT (BHU), and industry partners involved in research and development activities.
- 2. Sh. Nikesh Arora (EEE '89), was conferred with the Distinguished Alumnus Award under the category of Profession for 2021-22. He is presently serving as the CEO and Chairman of Palo Alto Networks, a global cyber-security leader. On 9th December, 2022, during his visit to IIT (BHU), he interacted with the Director, Deans, HoDs and the students who were awarded the IIT (BHU) Foundation scholarship in the academic year 2021-22 and 2022-23.
- 3. AlphaGrep Securities Pvt. Ltd. conducted its AlphaGrep Merit Scholarship 2022 program. Around 51 students from IIT (BHU), Varanasi participated and a total of 22 awards were won by the students. Anshu (CSE '23) was declared the All India Winner and received a prize money of Rs. 5 lakh. The campus winner, Ansh Gupta (CSE '23), also received a sum of Rs. 3 lakh as prize money. 10 students were in the top 10 category winning an amount of Rs. 50,000 each, while 10 students were in top 20 category winning Rs. 10,000 each as prize money.


Placement/Internship Updates

With the clock hitting 12 at the midnight of 1st December, began the conquest that the batch of 2023 had been preparing for all along. The rooms of New Dhanrajgiri witnessed this extravaganza first-hand as the placement season 2022-23 kicked off at the hostel premises. With the dedicated efforts from the Training and Placement Cell, IIT (BHU), Varanasi the college saw a sturdy placement season despite the challenges posed by the recession. We recieved 485 internship offers from 99 companies and 305 PPOs from 71 reputed companies.

By 5PM of 6th December 2022, we had a total of 1014 placement offers in over 288 profiles by companies looking for the the next generation of industry experts our at prestigious Institute. IIT (BHU) Foundation Scholarship



IIT (BHU) Foundation announced the recipients of its scholarship for the academic session 2022-23. The scholarship is funded through the IIT (BHU) Access Fund established in 2021 with seed funding of US \$ 2 million from an IIT (BHU) alumnus,

Sh. Nikesh Arora (EEE '89), and the Palo Alto Network Foundation. All incoming students can apply for the scholarship which covers tuition and medical insurance of the student for four years of their engineering education.

22 students from the incoming batch of 2022 were awarded the scholarship this year. Sh. Nikesh Arora interacted with the scholarship awardees on 9th December, 2022, in the presence of Prof. Pramod Kumar Jain, the Director of IIT (BHU), Deans and



other faculty members. Sh. Arora delivered an inspirational speech and shared with the students anecdotes from his college days.

Innovation @ IIT (BHU)



R-ABI, IIT (BHU), Varanasi participated in the 'Kissan Samman Sammelan' with 7 startups, held at Mela Ground, New Delhi, on 17th & 18th October, 2022. The event was organized by the Ministry of Agriculture and Farmers Welfare and inaugurated by our Hon'ble

Prime Minister Sh. Narendra Modi. The founder of Manwani's Innovative Pearl Culture LLP, Sh. Ashok Manwani, was awarded the 'Innovative Farmer's Award' by the Society of Krishi Vigyan, Gwalior on 19th October, 2022.

On the occasion of Children's Day, Atal Innovation Mission (AIM) organized a 'Do it yourself' program at 10,000 Atal Tinkering Labs (ATLs) across the country. IIT (BHU), being a member of MoE's Institute of Innovation Council (IIC), is a mentor institute for 3 ATLs and nominated I-3F staff to these labs for mentoring at the said event.

Sh. Piyush Goyal, Minister of Commerce and Industry, Gol, visited the Atal Incubation Centre, BHU on 11th November, 2022 to interact with startups, where 4 startups of I3-F got the opportunity to showcase their product.



Research & Development

Research and Development have always been the linchpin at IIT (BHU), Varanasi. The Institute has sought to align its R&D focus on the primary goal of nation-building and has undertaken several projects to put that to effect.

A total of 117 testing/consultancy projects were carried out this month, amounting to a sum of Rs. 2,32,36,707/-. Moreover, one patent was filed by Prof. Vikash Kumar Dubey

and Ms. Preeti Ranjan of the School of Biochemical Engineering. One patent was also granted this month, which had been filed in 2018.

Faculty Achievements



Dr. Ram Sharan Singh, Professor at the Department of Chemical Engineering, has been nominated as a Fellow of the Biotech Research Society of India (BRSI). The felicitation ceremony was held at IIT Guwahati.

Dr. Pranjal Chandra, Associate Professor at the School of Biochemical Engineering, has received the coveted honor of the Young Scientist Award in the biological sciences section for the Year 2022 from the Indian Society of Chemists and Biologists (ISCB). His research team has developed several commercially viable biosensing device



prototypes and novel nano-engineered materials for diverse applications, including healthcare, environmental monitoring, and food-related analysis.



Dr. Aditya Kumar Padhi, Asst. Prof. at the School of Biochemical Engineering, has received the prestigious 'Young Scientist Award for the Year 2022' from the Bioinformatics and Drug Discovery Society, for pioneering

work in the areas of Bioinformatics and Computational Biology. Dr. Padhi was endowed with this award organized by the BIDDS Annual Awards-2022 ceremony at the Department of Bioinformatics, Alagappa University, Karaikudi, Tamil Nadu held from 21st-25th November, 2022.

Dr. R. K. Srivastava, professor at the Department of Electrical Engineering, IIT (BHU), has been awarded the 'Dr. G. K. Dubey Memorial Lifetime Achievement Award 2022' at the 9th IEE UP Section International Conference on Electrical, Computer and Electronics Engineering (UPICON-2022) held at IIIT Allahabad.



Students' Updates

The Student Counselling Services conducted a 3-day induction for the 1600+ new entrants at the Institute.
