







# **Institute Updates**



1. Despite tough global circumstances, the Training and Placement Cell, IIT (BHU), Varanasi left no stone unturned in providing dream opportunities to the students of the Institute. A total of 315 pre-placement offers (PPOs) were received by the students from several companies, and they bagged more than 1250 on-campus placement offers. The average package amounted to Rs. 22,73,504/- per annum and the highest package was Rs. 1,20,00,000/- per annum. Reputed firms like Graviton, Microsoft, Airbnb, Rakuten, Walmart, Deloitte India - DS, Sprinklr, Oracle, Uber, Confluent, Flipkart Internet Pvt. Ltd. and Accenture Japan Ltd. recruited the students of the Institute.



2. As the year proceeds, the Research and Development sector at the Institute continually strengthens its presence as a major supporting pillar. The number of patents filed has already reached 12 within the first four months of 2023, while 12 patents have been granted as well. This year saw 54 projects being sanctioned with a total funding of Rs. 16,87,98,519 and 459 Testing/Consultancy projects were carried out amounting to a sum of Rs. 7,84,11,927.

The Institute witnessed exceptional opportunities during the 2022–2023 placement season, with offers from several reputed companies across a variety of industries.



A total of 1255 placement offers were made till 9th May, 2023 with a maximum package of Rs. 1,20,00,000/per annum and an average package of Rs. 22,73,504/per annum. With offers received from various renowned firms such as

Wells Fargo, Graviton, Goldman Sachs, Plutus Research, Sprinklr, JP Morgan Chase & Co., Flipkart Internet Pvt. Ltd., Accenture Japan Ltd., Navi, Confluent, Microsoft, Airbnb, Thoughtspot, Uber, Rakuten, Accenture Solutions, Oracle and many more, the placement season concludes.

# Research and Development

Deep and innovative research at the Institute has always been seen as a catalyst in transforming societies, and thus, the encouragement of development projects is considered quintessential. Hence, a significant increase in research/consultancy projects has been observed.

On 10th April, 2023, one patent was filed, whose inventors were Dr. Mahendra Rathore, Dr. Vishesh Mishra, and Dr. Urbi Chatterjee. Moreover, 3 patents were granted this month, out of which one was filed in 2018, and the other two in 2019.

A total of 17 startups were shortlisted for the RIC-2, including 11 seed-stage and 6 pre-seed stage startups. The committee finally selected 4 start-ups for the final grant of Rs. 55 lakhs which will be disbursed to the start-ups in 3 tranches.


