








# **Institute Updates**







2. Dr. Samir V. Kamat, Secretary, Department of Defense (R&D) and Chairman, Defense Research and Development Organisation (DRDO), inaugurated the DRDO Industry Academy-Centre of Excellence (DIA-CoE) at IIT (BHU) on 6th October, 2023. The center will aim to reduce India's defense imports and make it self-reliant in the defense field by developing indigenous defense technologies. Under DIA-CoE, DRDO will establish technical facilities and infrastructure required for technological development programs in various verticals. In the first phase, three verticals - powder metallurgy, functional electronics materials, and high-power microwave sources and devices, were selected for research.



3. The 12th edition of the IITBHU Model United Nations conference was organized from 29th September, 2023 to 1st October, 2023. The opening ceremony was attended by Yogesh Chabria, founder of Happionaire Way, a bestselling author, and a keynote TEDx speaker, and the closing ceremony witnessed Anil Trigunayat, former Indian ambassador to Jordan, Libya, and Malta, as the Chief Guest. The conference aimed to foster deliberations on global challenges among young minds nationwide and covered various topics, including the globalization of healthcare, climate change, the effects of capitalism, and many more.



4. The inauguration ceremony of Mental Wellness Week at IIT (BHU), organized by the Wellness Council at the Student Counselling Services on 8th October, 2023, was attended by Smt. Nirmala Sitharaman, Finance Minister, Government of India. At the event, the Finance Minister addressed the students, motivating them to find work-life balance, and shared details of various initiatives of the Central Government for the mental well-being of every citizen.



5. The first phase of the mission to achieve carbon neutrality, which was launched on Independence Day by Prof. P. K. Jain, Director, IIT (BHU), concluded successfully with an event on Gandhi Jayanti. Under this campaign, the Institute adopted the Ghoshila, Rameswaram, and Hirampur villages and conducted household surveys and awareness programs. Promoting carbon neutrality in daily life, the mission proceeded with an awareness march taken out by Kasturba Mahila Inter College in Ghoshila village and a carbon-neutral case study competition held for IIT (BHU) students on 28th September, 2023.

## Research and Development

For any institution to be deemed as progressive and advancing, the level of attention provided to its RnD sector proves to be a significant measure. Recognizing the necessity of innovative research, IIT (BHU), Varanasi continues to make huge strides in this respect and put in complete effort towards the execution of its research projects.

Between 1st September, 2023 and 30th September, 2023, seven patents have been filed, 32 published and 2 granted, out of which one was filed in 2017 and another in 2019.


Sh. Vikash Agrawal (CHE '95) (Chairman of Levrx Technology Inc.) received the award for Distinguished Service to the Institute.




Divyansh Chandra Roy (ECE '23) President's Gold Medalist


