

**IIT-BHU researchers invent low-cost prefilled dual chamber syringe :**

A research group of IIT-BHU has invented a low-cost prefilled dual chamber syringe, and also applied for patent for this healthcare innovation.

Under the supervision of Dr Sanjeev Kumar Mahto, researchers of Tissue Engineering and Biomicrofluidics (TEBM) laboratory, School of Biomedical Engineering have invented the dual chamber prefilled syringe with the help of 3D printing.
