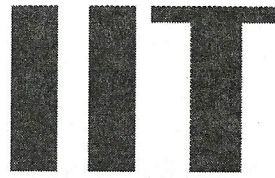

NOTIFICATION

In order to maintain cleanliness and eco-friendly environment in the Institute, the Director has been pleased to order as under :

1. Use of any single-use-and-throw item made of plastic or thermocoal is banned and is strictly prohibited on the campus. This prohibition applies to use of plastic or thermocoal cups, glasses, bottles, plates, carry bags, etc. in the GTAC/Hostel Messes/seminars/symposia/workshops or any other official/non-official function in the Institute. In lieu of plastics or thermocoal, items made of eco-friendly materials such as paper or earthenware may be used. It is requested that wide publicity should be given among all the concerned.

All the vendors/contractors engaged for providing catering services for functions organised in the Institute should be informed of the same with the strict instruction that violation of it will attract strict penal action against them including imposition of monetary fine and ban on hiring their services in the Institute. Dy. Chief Proctor is requested to ensure that this gets implemented by working with Chairman CoW, DoSA, Coordinator, GTAC, IIT Guest House, Heads/Coordinators of Depts/Schools.

2. Students, hostel staff and mess maharaj must be motivated to segregate the waste generated from the rooms of the students, lobbies and mess area of the hostels before disposing to the colour coded dustbin situated outside the hostel. For this purpose awareness program should be started at Institute level through pamphlet, posters and stickers.
3. Normal water rather than bottled water will be served in the official meetings and functions of the Institute.
4. Regular testing of potability of drinking water must be done in the hostels and departments etc. For this purpose, a proper monitoring mechanism must be evolved at the appropriate levels.
